Lifesaving Donor-Funded Tools and Solutions

Your support in 2024 made it possible to acquire advanced medical technology, essential patient care equipment, and staff resources that directly impact the well-being of our community.

From life-saving diagnostic tools to innovative pain management solutions and even state-of-the-art training simulators, these donor-funded projects ensure that our healthcare team has the tools they need to deliver world class care. Each of these advancements plays a crucial role in improving patient outcomes, enhancing comfort, and expanding access to specialized treatments – ultimately allowing us to better serve those who rely on us for their care.

Telemedicine Cart

This leading-edge tool allows Peterson to provide the most comprehensive access to care for all patients. Through technology and strategic partnerships, patients have live, real-time access to neurologists and other specialties that would not otherwise be available.



Transcutaneous CO2 Monitors

This technology delivers continuous, non-invasive monitoring of carbon dioxide levels in the body, allowing for early detection of respiratory complications, minimizing the need for painful blood draws, and enabling our team to make timely adjustments to ventilation settings, especially in critically ill patients or newborns.



Cryostat Tissue Freezing

A cryostat improves patient outcomes by enabling rapid, accurate tissue analysis through its ability to quickly freeze and precisely section tissue samples, allowing for faster diagnoses during surgery or in critical situations, which leads to timely and appropriate treatment decisions.

Parks Flo Lab SX2

This state-of-the-art vascular diagnostic system helps record, review, and detect circulation issues like peripheral artery disease (PAD) and deep vein thrombosis (DVT) early, allowing for timely intervention and better patient outcomes. Using non-invasive technology, it provides real-time, high-resolution Doppler waveforms, ensuring fast and accurate results without discomfort. Designed for ease of use, it enables healthcare professionals to efficiently assess blood flow, guiding effective treatment decisions while minimizing unnecessary tests or procedures.



Spider2 Limb Positioner

The Spider2 Limb Positioner provides effective traction and improved visualization for shoulder arthroscopies. This device also enables the surgeon to manipulate the arm without needing an additional staff support. We have acquired two positioners for both inpatient and outpatient shoulder surgeries.

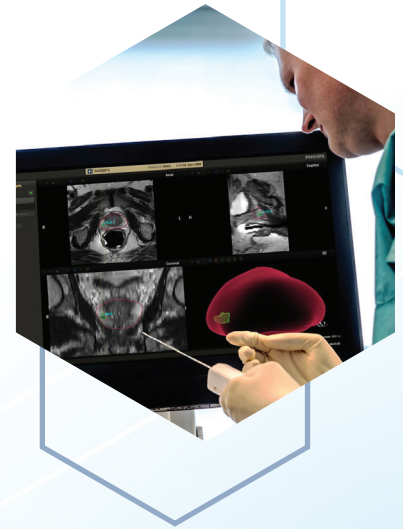
Staff Lockers

DynaCAD Breast and Prostate Software

This Computer-Aided Detection software enhances diagnostic images and improves both confidence and accuracy in image review of breast and prostate exams. This software works by populating 3D regions of interest that may require more attention, alerting the Radiologist to review more closely, and eliminating the need to biopsy tissue unnecessarily. Earlier detection rate with the DynaCAD is the new standard of care for breast and prostate imaging.



nVoq® Speech Recognition Software

This speech recognition software is a transformative tool in the realm of healthcare documentation, offering unparalleled benefits in efficiency, accuracy, and workflow optimization. By seamlessly converting spoken words into text in real-time, nVoq streamlines the documentation process for our Hospice team, allowing them to focus more on patient care and less on administrative tasks.

SIM NewB® Simulator

The SIM NewB is an advanced medical simulator that replicates the physiology and responses of a real newborn. This simulator is a vital tool for medical training and education, allowing healthcare professionals to practice various procedures and interventions in a realistic, risk-free environment. It can simulate breathing, crying, and medical emergencies for valuable hands-on training.



Ear, Nose, and Throat Navigation Equipment

The Acclarent TruDi Navigation system is a medical technology designed to enhance accuracy and precision during endoscopic sinus surgeries. It utilizes advanced imaging and navigation capabilities to assist surgeons in performing minimally invasive procedures with improved outcomes.



Moses™ Holmium Laser

The Moses Holmium Laser is a cutting-edge medical device used primarily in procedures to treat kidney stones expected in a modern urologic practice. It utilizes advanced laser technology to precisely target large and complex stones to aid in pulverizing them. Due to this precision, it also is increasingly used for laser enucleation of the prostate. Because of its increased energy focus, this new laser allows for faster more efficient destruction of a variety of kidney stones. This increased efficiency reduces operating time, allowing physicians and staff to treat more complex cases here at Peterson rather than referring them elsewhere.

Pro Plus Mattresses

Designed with advanced pressure relief technology, these mattresses feature specialized foam layers that evenly distribute pressure, significantly reducing the risk of pressure injuries, especially important for long-term or immobile patients. The multi-layered construction contours to the body, providing superior comfort while enhanced edge support ensures patient safety when getting in and out of bed. Hygiene is also a top priority, with Advanced Moistureclimate® technology that efficiently removes heat and moisture at the push of a button.



Nitronox Plus® 50/50

Nitronox Plus is set to transform childbirth and empower women during labor. This innovative pain management solution combines nitrous oxide and oxygen for safe and effective relief during labor and delivery, enhancing maternal wellbeing and ensuring positive birthing experiences.

Portable Vital Sign Machines

Two of the three existing vital sign machines were replaced in the Cardiac Cath Lab. This equipment offers a compact design, user-friendly interface, intuitive functionality, and portability, enhancing patient comfort and convenience. These machines are essential to teams at Peterson, delivering high-quality care with greater flexibility and responsiveness to improve patient outcomes.

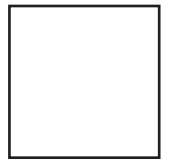
